**** Item ranges are not whole numbers because domain scores are a composite of four or five individual items.

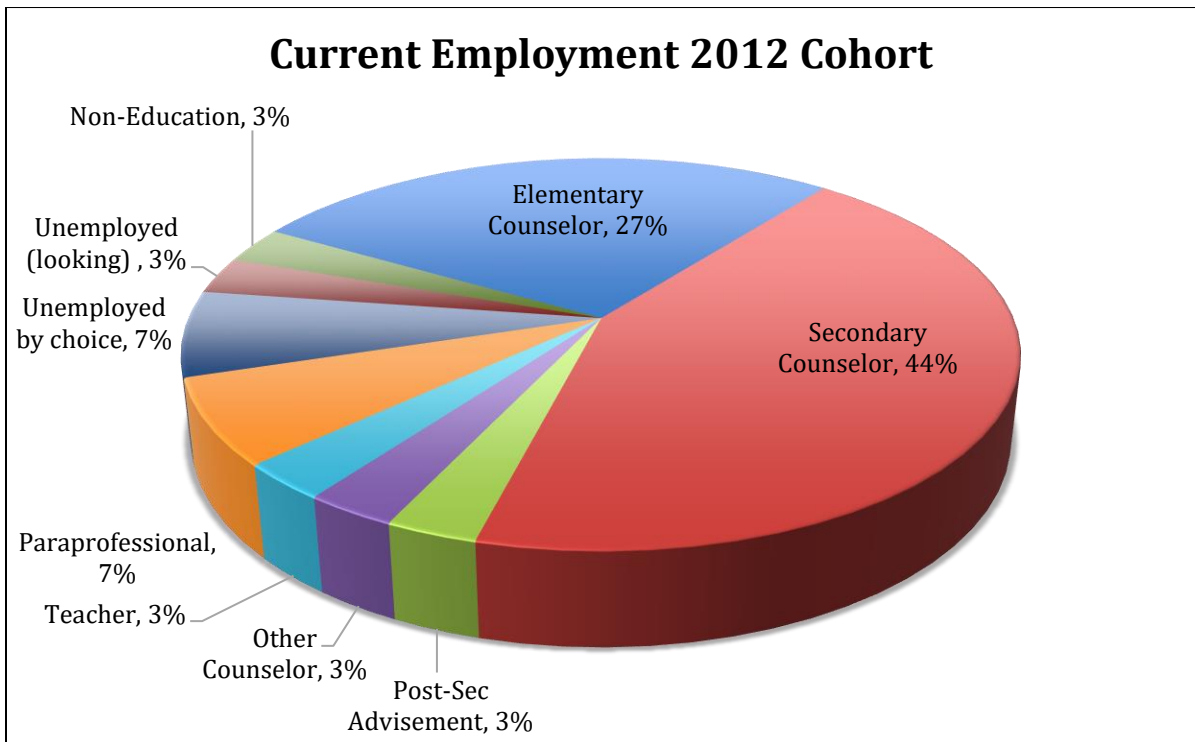
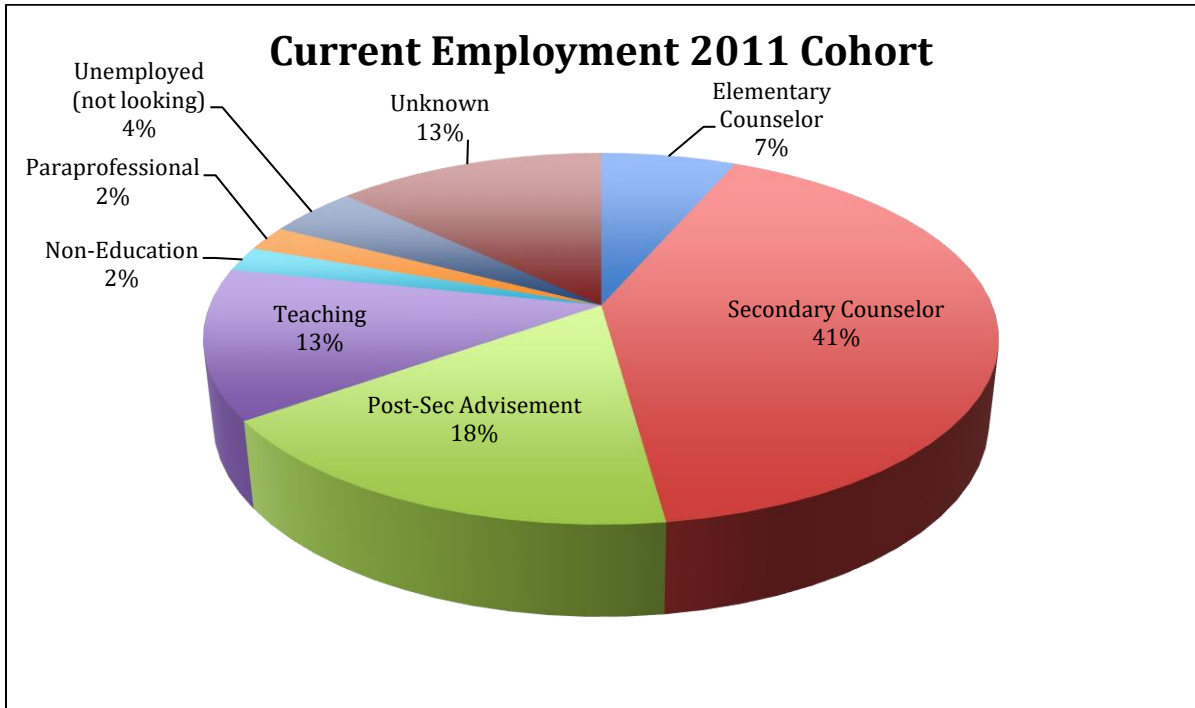

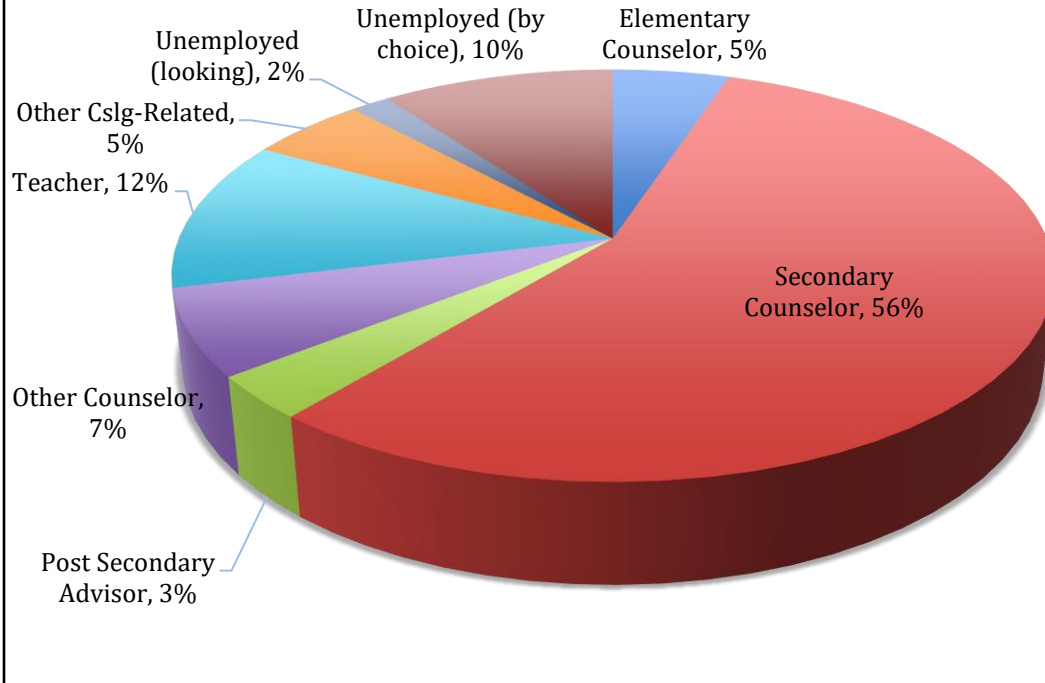
