Secure and HIPAA-Compliant electronic data capture tool	Yes, data @ USU	No, data in cloud
Templates availability for some common survey/assessment instrument	X	X
Multiple forms can be linked to a single participant ID	X	
Share and collaborate with other account holders	X	X
Permission schemes and data access groups	Detailed	Limited
Allows direct data entry by study staff, & capture/input from participants.	X	
Tablet/phone app allows for off-line data collection in the field	X	X
Branching logic and skip patterns based on previous answers to questions	X	X
Anonymous responses to surveys using a web link	X	X
Built in double data entry, data comparison tools and quality checks	X	Work-arounds
Calendar and scheduling of longitudinal events in the future	X	"panels"
