Psychology Instructor Requirements for PSY 1010 Concurrent Enrollment

Education:

- 1) PhD in Psychology preferred
- 2) Master's degree in Psychology or a closely related field may be accepted

Background:

- 1) For individuals without a PhD in Psychology, a record of successful completion (with grades of B or above) in the following courses (or their equivalent) taken in the past 15 years:
 - a. PSY 1010 – General Psychology
 - b. PSY 1100 or 2100 – Lifespan Development or Adolescent Development
 - c. PSY 1400/1410 – Behavior Analysis / lab
 - d. PSY 3010 – Psych Stats
 - e. PSY 3210 – Abnormal Psych
 - f. PSY 3460 – Neuroscience I
 - g. PSY 3500 – Research Methods
 - h. PSY 3510 – Social Psychology
 - i. PSY 4240 – Multicultural Psychology

Process for instructor approval

Potential Instructor submits to Psychology Department Head via e-mail the following materials:

- 1) Current CV
- 2) Transcripts (unofficial) of graduate and undergraduate coursework
- 3) For AP teachers, the AP course syllabus and the college board report for AP exam outcomes

Psychology Department Head reviews materials, consulting with members of the undergraduate teaching committee as needed, and notifies individual regarding approval status.
