



Integrated College and Community Studies – Certificate of Proficiency

2-year program of study

Program Requirements: A minimum of 23 credits are required to receive the Certificate. Students must take and pass all required “core” courses *for credit*. All other required and elective courses may be taken for credit or audit, depending on student's abilities and support needs. Guidance is provided in selecting appropriate elective courses. Electives must be approved by advisor prior to enrolling.
