- A grade of C grade or better is required for the major coursework, including the respective statistics courses.
- Overall 2.0 GPA required until graduation
- Courses taken under the former FCHD prefix still fulfill the HDFS course requirements.
- 120 credit hours are required for graduation from USU. Depending on the number of credit hours that you have completed prior to being accepted to the major (either at USU or as transfer credits from another institution), you may need to take additional electives to fill the necessary 120 credit hours.
- Out of the 120 credits hours that are required for graduation, 40 credits must be upper-division (3000+ level).
- There are minors available which can be used to fill the credit-hour requirement, but a minor is not required for this major.
