Course Description

The ITLS MA and MEd degree programs allow you to complete a creative project in lieu of a formal thesis or an internship. Your advisor is responsible for approving, monitoring, and signing off the work completed for this requirement.

The purpose of the creative project is to provide an opportunity for you to apply knowledge to improve a teaching/training skill or other interest for professional improvement. Select a project that will permit you to demonstrate a broad variety of skills and knowledge developed during the coursework phase of your degree program. Review the experiences you have had thus far in your program to help identify possible options. This can be something you are tasked with at your place of employment, something of personal interest, or something someone else instigates. Your completed project should demonstrate that you are now a 'master' of the program content. Theory and design should be integral components.
