University Minimum Graduation Requirements:

- Total Credits: 120 earned credits minimum, 30 of these must be USU credits
- A GPA of 2.0 is required for courses taken at USU
- Total credits with C- or above: 100 credits minimum
- USU credits within the Major: 10 credits minimum
- Upper-Division credits (3000 level or above): 40 credits minimum,
- Upper-Division credits (3000 level or above) must be completed at USU: 20 credits minimum
- **Please note: A minimum of 72 of the 120 credits for the baccalaureate degree must carry the A, A-, B, B-, C+, C, C-, D+, D designation, unless the major department or college changes this limitation.**

Major Related Requirements:

- Admission: 2.0 overall GPA required
- Graduation: 2.0 overall GPA & 2.5 major GPA required
- **All RAM-prefix required courses must be a C or better grade**
- All courses required for the major require a letter grade (e.g., A, A-, B+, B, B-, etc.). **Pass/Fail grading is not permitted for the major courses, excluding RAM 2250.**
