A thesis equivalent project will be required if the M.A./M.S. degree was completed without a thesis. Students admitted with a master's degree are responsible for all the coursework in the Combined Program. Decisions regarding what courses (including practica) may be waived or transferred are made on a case-by-case basis. Students entering with a strong applied master's degree may expect to reduce their completion time by one year.
