**NOTICE OF FILING**

An application concerning the employment of an alien worker for the following permanent position will be filed with the U.S. Department of Labor. This Notice of Filing will be posted for at least 10 consecutive business days, ending between 30 and 180 days before filing the permanent labor certification application.

Position: Assistant Professor (Special Education)

Duties: Entry-level, tenure-track position. Teach face-to-face and web-based synchronous and asynchronous undergraduate and/or graduate classes in Special Education; developing an active line of research that includes seeking extramural funding to support graduate students and research; supervise undergraduate and graduate field experiences; advise and mentor graduate students; and provide service to university by collaborating in department and university program development and committees.

Qualifications: Doctorate in special education or related field at time of appointment. Demonstrated direct service experience with individuals with disabilities; demonstrated history of positive working relationships with teachers, clinicians, administrators, and faculty; demonstrated expertise in either: (i) evidence-based reading and language arts instruction for students with disabilities, or (ii) early childhood special education. Required skills and other requirements may be earned during advanced educational studies. Qualified candidates who have **one (or more)** of the following qualifications will be given preference: demonstrated expertise in effective instruction and curricular adaptation to support the inclusion of children with disabilities; demonstrated expertise in explicit and systematic instruction; research focus on children who represent culturally and linguistically diverse populations; relevant birth-12 grade teaching experience; demonstrated expertise in single case research design; demonstrated expertise in quantitative analysis including multi-level modeling and other advanced statistical techniques; demonstrated expertise in multi-tiered systems of academic and behavior support (response to intervention and school-wide positive behavior interventions and supports); demonstrated expertise in applications of behavior analysis in education; demonstrated ability to obtain extramural funding for research and/or training activities; and demonstrated expertise in assessment, evaluation, and/or policy in education.

Salary: \$81,888 per calendar year; \$67,000 per academic year (Utah State University will pay or exceed the prevailing wage, as determined by the U.S. Department of Labor.)
