

Transition Education and Services Certificate Program

If you are interested in or are already working with transition-age individuals with disabilities, the Transition Education and Services Certificate program is for you! Prepare for or enhance your career working with youth and students with disabilities as they transition from secondary education to postsecondary participation in employment, education, and living.

In the Transition Education and Services Certificate program, you will:

- Receive applied training that prioritizes areas of high need and expected growth.
- Learn research-based, transition-specific competencies to apply in your career.
- Connect and network with others who are doing this work in education, the public sector, disability resource and rehabilitation centers, independent living centers, workforce services, the justice system, and many other settings.
- Earn a specialized transition certificate aligned with research, field standards, and legislative mandates.

Program at-a-glance:

- 14 credits taken over three semesters (fall, spring, and summer)
- Classes available in person in Logan or streamed live online in the evenings
- Total certificate cost: \$6832, or \$488 per credit hr.
- Certificate can be taken before or added to the USU Master of Rehabilitation Counseling degree
