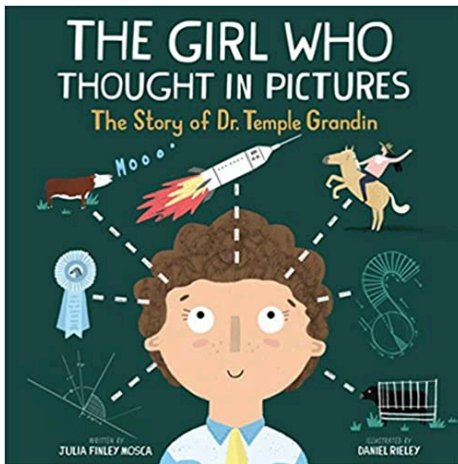


The Girl Who Thought in Pictures: The Story of Dr. Temple Grandin
