



## How to Apply for a Secondary Education Clinical Placement

All students requiring a clinical placement must use the eGrad application to submit a placement request. **Applications for Spring 2026 must be completed before January 9, 2026.** Late applications will not be accommodated.

1. Log in to <https://egrad.ed.usu.edu/>
2. On the left side of the screen, choose Submit New Form.



3. Click on Teacher Education and Leadership and a selection of forms will appear on the right side of the screen.



4. Choose Secondary Clinical Placement Application and select a term from the dropdown menu, then Start Form.
