- Communicate with parents for PPAT Task 1 by **January 28**
- Send home PPAT permission forms by **January 28**
- Complete and upload PPAT Task 1 by **February 7**
- Complete PPAT Task 2 and 3 by **February 28**
- Participate in Triad Conference during the week of **March 28 – April 1** --dual majors only--
- Complete PPAT Task 4 by **March 28**
- Last day in school – **April 22**
- Complete Evaluation of Mentor Teacher/Supervisor by **April 29** (Link will be emailed.)

- Do Formative Feedback Form #1 by **February 18**
- Participate in Triad Conference during the week of **March 28 – April 1** --dual majors only--

Reminders

- Lesson plans written by the student teacher are required for all lessons that the student teacher teaches. They must be submitted to the mentor teacher prior to the actual teaching of the lesson for comment, suggestions, and approval.
- Lesson plans must also be submitted to the supervisor prior to each observation.
- Student teachers cannot be absent more than a total of 3 days during semester.
- Student teachers must keep district contract hours at the building where they are located and follow the district calendar, **NOT** the USU calendar.
