Student Teacher Responsibilities

- Attend mandatory Student Teacher Orientation – **August 26**
- First day in school – **August 27**
- Participate in Triad Conference during the weeks of **August 26 – September 6**
- Communicate with parents by **September 6**
- Complete Bi-Weekly Feedback Forms throughout the semester as indicated in your Canvas course
- Participate in Triad Conference during the week of **October 14 - 18 (dual majors only)**
- Last day in school – **December 6**
- Complete Evaluation of Mentor Teacher/Supervisor by **December 13** (Link will be emailed.)

Mentor Teacher Responsibilities

- Participate in Triad Conference during the weeks of **August 26 – September 6**
- Participate in Triad Conference during the week of **October 14 – 18 (for dual majors only)**
- Mentor teachers **do not** complete any forms during the semester. Student teachers will complete Bi-Weekly Feedback Forms throughout the semester.
- Do Online **Final** Summative Evaluation (link will be emailed around November 27) by **December 13**

Supervisor Responsibilities

- Facilitate Triad Conference during weeks of **August 26 – September 6**
- Complete STER-Fillable Form/Observation #1 by **September 20**
- Complete STER-Fillable Form/Observation #2 by **October 11**
- Facilitate Triad Conference during the week of **October 14 – 18 (for dual majors only)**
- Complete STER-Fillable Form/Observation #3 by **November 15**
- Do Online **Final** Summative (link will be emailed around November 27) by **December 13**

Reminders

- Lessons plans written by the student teacher are required for all lessons that the student teacher teaches. They must be submitted to the mentor teacher prior to the actual teaching of the lesson for comment, suggestions, and approval.
- Lesson plans must also be submitted to the supervisor prior to each observation.
- Student teachers cannot be absent more than a total of 3 days during semester.
- Student teachers must keep district contract hours at the building where they are located and follow the district calendar, **NOT** the USU calendar.
