FOR ADMISSION TO TEACHER EDUCATION & INSTRUCTIONS

One semester before you begin the Secondary Teacher Education Program, submit this completed application, signed by the content advisors for your content areas. Applicant must successfully complete at least 12 college credits. Deadlines: Fall admission for Spring classes – Oct. 1, Spring admission for fall classes – Mar. 1.

Admission to Teacher Education must be approved by both the Secondary Education Program and the office of the Associate Dean for Undergraduate Studies, Applicants must first be recommended by advisors for their teaching majors and, if applicable, teaching minors, and then by the advisor in the Secondary Education Program. The application form and all required documentation are then submitted to the Associate Dean for formal approval, and students will then be permitted to register for courses in the Secondary Teacher Education program.

To begin the admission process, read and understand all admission criteria, then meet with your major advisor and fill out Parts I and II of the Admission Application together. After your major and minor advisors have signed the application form, schedule an appointment with a Secondary Teacher Education Advisor to complete the process. To schedule an advising appointment: https://cehs.usu.edu/advising/, and select Teacher Education and Leadership (TEAL). You will need to upload the signed STEP Application (Parts I, II, and III) along with the SCED List serve confirmation email PDF, and FBI/BCI Background Check clearance email PDF to the eGrad database.

How to Apply to STEP using the e-GRAD link:

Locate your signed 1) STEP Application (2 pages) from your content advisor(s) and STEP advisor, 2) FBI/BCI Background check clearance email and 3) SCED List serve confirmation email. Using Google Chrome, go to the website, https://egrad.ed.usu.edu/ Click on the box e-Grad Application Portal. In the e-Grad program, select "Secondary Education" from the Departments list and then "Secondary Education Program Application". Follow the directions and enter your information. Make sure to select the semester that you plan to start the STEP. Submit the application and notify your STEP advisor that you have completed your portion of the application.
